

DESCRIPTION

Elm Court was developed in 2009 and provides a range of modern workshop / trade counter units from 1,096 - 2,783 sq ft (units can be combined subject to availability). Totalling 30,945 sq ft, the 18 units are split into 4 terraced blocks set within a secure fenced site with gated entrance and CCTV. The adjacent blocks face each other across a central courtyard, providing good parking provision and circulation space. The units have been constructed to a high specification and offer 4m to underside of haunch, with overhead sectional loading doors and 37.5kn/m2 floor loading. The estate also benefits from a three phase electricity supply.

Elm Court is situated in an established industrial location off Newbridge Road in Ellesmere Port. Ellesmere Port is a large town and port in Cheshire, south of the Wirral on the banks of the Manchester Ship Canal. Ellesmere Port is located near the interchange of the M56 and the M53 motorways, and Elm Court provides excellent transport links with J10 of the M53 2 minutes away and Junction 9 only 4 minutes drive away, via Oil Sites Road. The M53 provides direct access to Chester and the Wirral as well as the M56 and the northwest's wider motorway network and beyond. The schemeis an ideal base from which to service North Wales, Cheshire, Merseyside and the wider north west region.
